Trash Chute Application

Trash chutes are a tough spot to clean. When organic matter builds up on the walls, bends and around access points of the chute, poor sanitation, nasty odors and other problems can arise. The chutes typically have small access points and are usually tucked into tight out of the way areas of buildings making manual cleaning difficult if not impossible. That's where InVade™ Technology comes in.

The spray nozzle should be mounted high up in the trash chute, preferably at the uppermost access point where trash is deposited (A), and positioned to hit the walls of the chute.

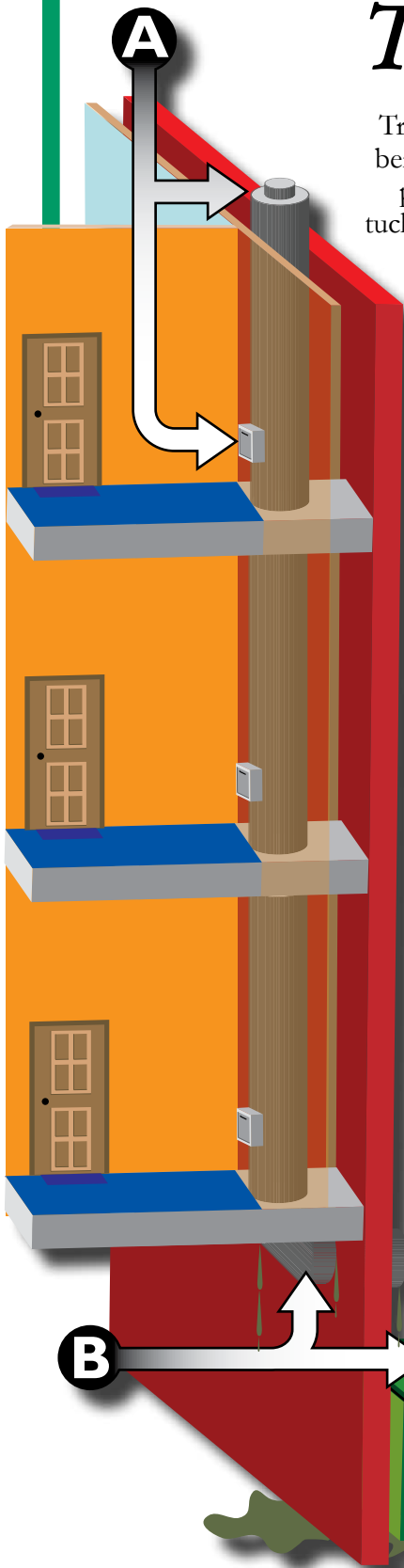
The InVade Spray Doser will automatically distribute a fine spray of InVade microbes at the time(s) and interval(s) of your choosing.

A longer spray time and shorter interval should be used for scummier chutes. The usage can likely be reduced for maintenance once problems are cleared up.

The InVade microbes will travel down the chute eating scum all the way down.

A second Spray Doser may be needed near the bottom of the chute and/or in the dumpster area. (B)
