



USDA National Organic Program Compliance Statement

Rockwell Labs Ltd hereby certifies that the following pesticides meet the requirements of the USDA National Organic Program (NOP) as published in The National List of Allowed and Prohibited Substances, as amended. The List encompasses synthetic products that are allowed for specific applications, and non-synthetic substances that are specifically prohibited. Naturally sourced products are presumed to be allowed if not specifically prohibited.

The NOP relates specifically to the production and processing of commodities (food and fiber) that bear the USDA organic logo. With respect to pesticides, it relates to products that may be used to treat for pests on organic crops, organic livestock and in and around organic processing facilities. The NOP does not relate to pesticides used for other purposes. Pesticides themselves are not certified as “organic”, unless they are made from organically produced commodities, which is not common.

The following borate and botanical products are allowed as insecticides when used according to the label, with no direct contact with organic food / feed / crops / commodities, except as noted:

InTice™ Rover Ant Bait

InTice™ 10 Perimeter Bait™

InTice™ Roach Bait

BorActin™ Insecticide Powder

EcoVia™ IB Insect Blok

EcoVia™ CA Contact Aerosol

EcoVia™ 3-in-1 Emulsifiable Concentrate (may be used directly on organic food / feed / crops / commodities)
